The field covers all aspects of human communication and the Communication Pathway at A-B Tech prepares transfer students for majors in communication studies, mass communication, journalism, public speaking, media production, public relations, advertising and marketing, or any combination of these disciplines.

A communication degree can prepare students for positions that value well-crafted, targeted, multi-channel messages in media relations and/ or production, corporate training, public relations, politics, education, and business. Communication majors develop skills in critical thinking, media literacy, visual literacy, research based analysis, public speaking, conflict management, and human communication competencies.
