All Pathways are designed to transfer to a four-year institution for eventual completion of a BA/BS or BFA degree.

The AFA degree requires students to take a significant concentration (31-34 credit hours) of art courses that are generally taught in the first two years of college. Students wishing to further their education in graphic design should consider this AFA option and will take courses such as Computer Art, Graphic Design, Interactive Media Design, Videography and Digital Photography. Graduates in this career path will generally pursue careers such as graphic design, animation, interactive design, illustration, sequential art, photography, videography, film, or media production.
